




When considering the various aspects of a possible peace agreement with Russia, which of the following aspects do you think could be compromised in order to sign the agreement, and which could not?













Do you believe in Ukraine's victory in the war with Russia?




To what extent would you say that the Ukrainian government is successfully negotiating with the US, the EU, and Russia regarding a possible peace agreement?




When do you think the war between Ukraine and Russia end?




With which of the following statements do you tend to agree most of all?




If you were to take part in a referendum on Ukraine's accession to the EU, how would you vote?





If you were to take part in a referendum on Ukraine's membership in NATO, how would you vote?

Do you think NATO is able to effectively defend itself in the event of Russia's aggression?




Do you think Russia is likely to attack a NATO member state?






How would you rate the heating situation in your home over the past week?


How would you rate the electricity supply situation in your home over the past week?




In your opinion, who is primarily responsible for the prolonged interruption of electricity, water and heat supplies following the Russian missile strikes? (up to 3 answers)
